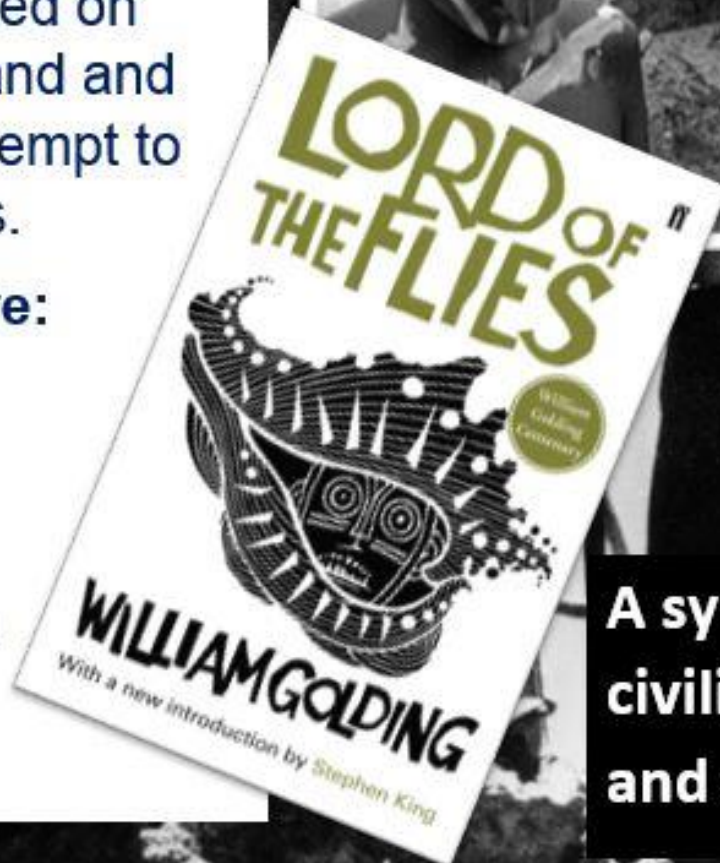


English – Lord of the Flies

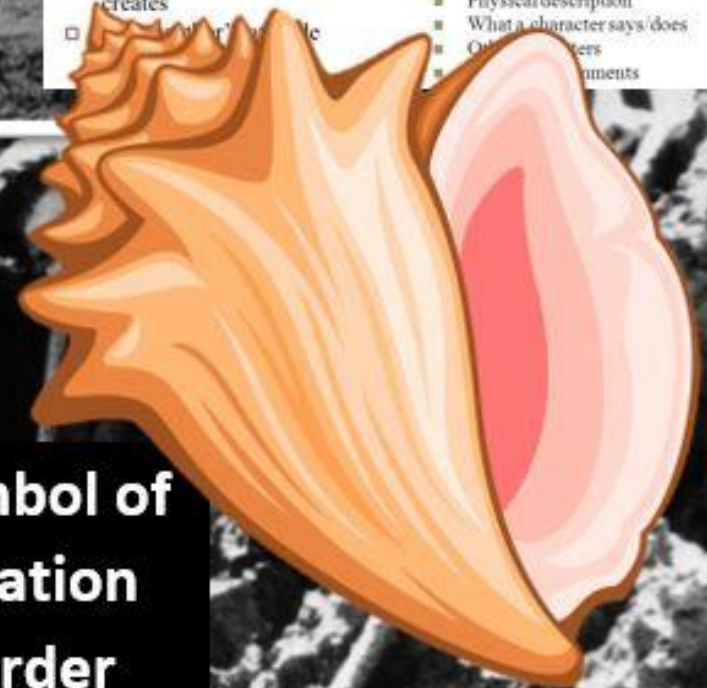

- Plot Diagram

- Protagonist: Central character of the story – should go through a change in the story
- Antagonist: character or force that works against the protagonist
- Characterization: techniques used to develop characters
 - Physical description
 - What a character says/does
 - Other characters' comments

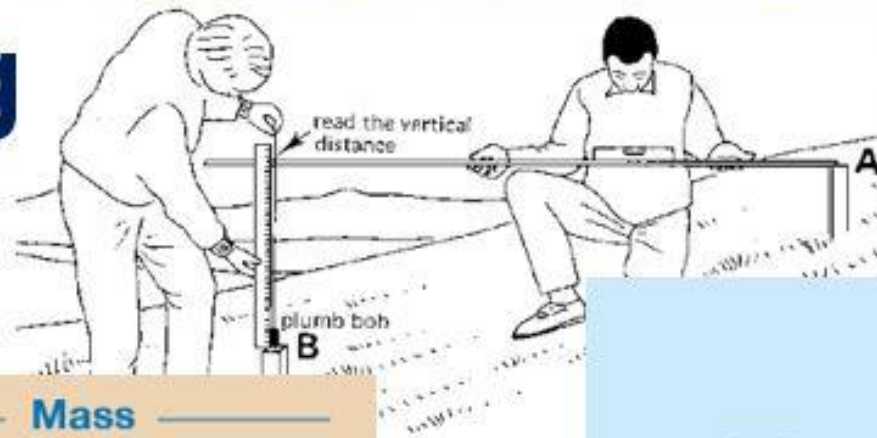

Maths – Measuring

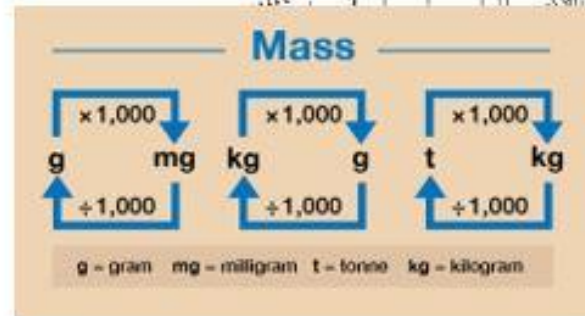
Measuring

- Volume
- Weight
- Height
- Distance
- Speed
- Time



Rearranging the formula

1. speed = **distance** ÷ time.
2. **distance** = speed × time.
3. time = **distance** ÷ speed.



Measure of Lengths

10 millimeters (mm) =	1 centimeter (cm)
10 centimeters =	1 decimeter (dm) = 100 millimeters
100 centimeter =	1 meter (m) = 1,000 millimeters
1000 meters =	1 kilometer (km)

There is 2200 ml of orange juice in a jug.
Find the volume in litres.

$$1 \text{ l} = 1000 \text{ ml}$$

$$2200 \rightarrow 2.2$$

$$2200 \div 1000 = 2.2$$

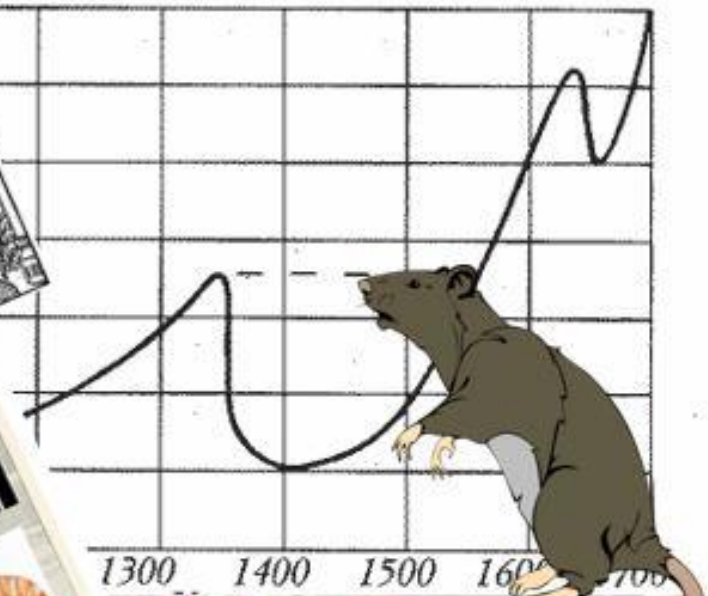

TOPIC – The Black Death 1346 -1353

The **Black Death** was a bubonic plague pandemic occurring from 1346 to 1353. It is the most fatal pandemic recorded in human history, causing the death of 75–200 million people.

Bubonic plague is caused by the bacterium *Yersinia pestis*,

The plague created religious, social and economic changes, which affected the course of European history.
